Newark Foodbank Most of us are



fortunate to have enough to eat but there are still many who greatly depend upon and benefit from Newark Foodbank. Please donate if you can, any of the following, and leave in Church Porch: packets of instant mash potato; tinned or microwaveable sponge puddings; sugar; jars of pasta sauce; tinned custard; tinned vegetables; biscuits; tinned/packet soup; tea bags 40/80’s; tinned meat such as spam or ham but not corned beef, cereal; long life juice; long life UHT milk but not evaporated or condensed; chocolate biscuits bars; tinned rice pudding; tinned tomatoes, tinned fruit; non food items such as shampoo; toothbrushes; washing up liquid; laundry tablets; toilet rolls; shower gel; liquid hand soap;
